## Subject: MFL

## Year 7

OVERVIEW

Students arrive at the Academy with different experiences of language learning. In Year 7 we equip students with the building blocks of phonics, grammar and vocabulary to be able to confidently listen, read, speak and write in Spanish. By the end of Year 7 we expect students to have a sound understanding of: Spanish sound and spelling correspondence, key grammatical concepts such as word order, gender of nouns, adjectival agreement and present tense verb conjugation and Spanish vocabulary from a variety of topics. Students will also be introduced to Hispanic culture throughout the vear.
