In Year 8, students build upon the vocabulary, phonics and grammar they have seen in Year 7 and continue strengthening the skills of listening, reading, speaking and writing. Students will be introduced to the future tense for the first time. By the end of Year 8 we expect students to have a sound understanding of: Spanish sound and spelling correspondence, key grammatical concepts such as present and future tense verb conjugation and Spanish vocabulary from a variety of topics. Students will also experience more Hispanic culture throughout the year.
